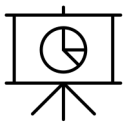

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

- Type of presentation: Oral / Poster
- Category: Faculty / Postgraduate / PhD students
- Mode: Microsoft Word format, Times New Roman font with size 12 & single line spacing.
- The abstract should include the abstract title, author names and affiliations.
- The abstract should be in a structured format.
- Original research: Introduction, Methodology, Results, Discussion & Conclusions.
- Case report: Introduction, Case Details & Discussion.
- Abstract should be followed by 3 to 5 keywords separated by a semicolon.
- Word limit: 250 words (excluding title, keywords, name of the authors and affiliation).
- The abstract should be sent to email ID: iamle2024abstract@gmail.com
- Last date of abstract submission: **15/08/2024**
- All abstracts will be reviewed and scrutinized by the scientific committee, and acceptance will be communicated via e-mail.
- Further details of presentations will be notified in the first week of September.



GUIDELINES FOR PRESENTATION

- The oral presentation must be prepared in a Microsoft PowerPoint format.
- The time limit for oral presentation is 6 minutes followed by a discussion of 2 minutes.
- The presenter should strictly adhere to the guidelines and time.
- All posters should be in printed format with a dimension of 4 feet (height) X 3 feet (width).
- Each poster will be allocated a designated place & time for display.
- The time limit for poster presentation is 3 minutes followed by a discussion of 2 minutes.
- The poster presenters should ensure their presence at the designated place at the time of evaluation.



Awards will be given to the best presentations in different categories.

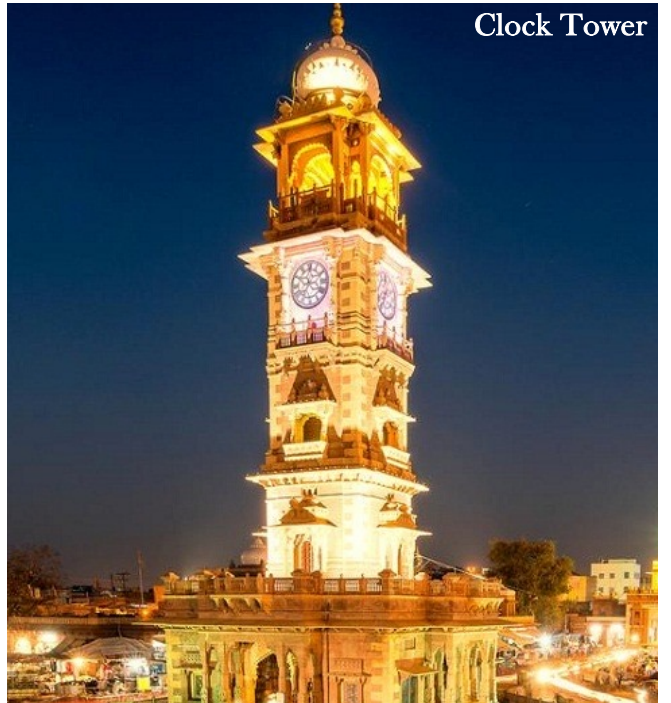
Jaswant Thada

Mandore Garden

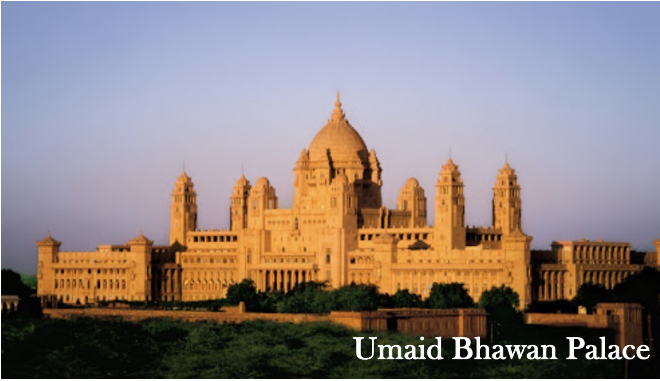

Clock Tower

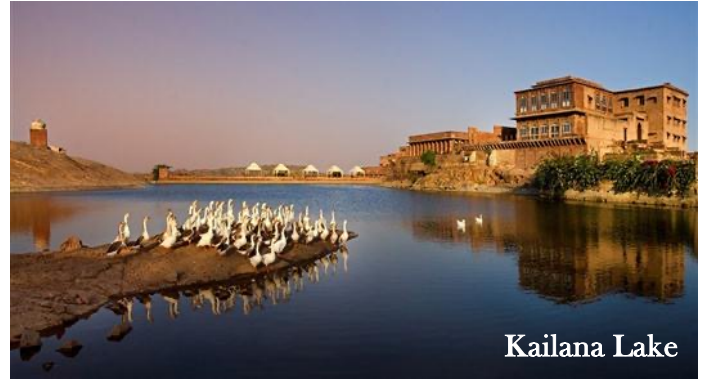

HOW TO REACH JODHPUR

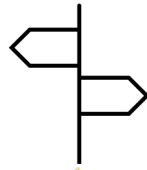
 **By Air:** Jodhpur has direct flights from various cities, including Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai, Jaipur, Bengaluru, Ahmedabad, Hyderabad, Pune, Belgaum and Indore. The airport is located 8 km from AIIMS, Jodhpur.

 **By Rail:** Jodhpur junction is a major railway station well connected to different parts of the country. The railway station is located 6 km from AIIMS, Jodhpur.

 **By Road:** Jodhpur is well connected to various cities by road via state and national highways.
