The following revised and additional conditions will be added:-

1. Page No. 4, “Term and Condition” Point no.4,:

For

The successful Tenderer will have to deposit the Bank Guarantee and commence the work within 7 days of acceptance of tender otherwise the contract may be cancelled and EMD will be forfeited.

Read

The successful Tenderer will have to deposit the Bank Guarantee and commence the work within **30 days of acceptance of tender** otherwise the contract may be cancelled and EMD will be forfeited.

2. Page No. 5, “Term and Condition” Point no. 21,:

For

The technically qualified Bidder who submits the lowest financial bid amount shall be declared as successful bidder (L1) and communication to that effect shall be made subject to approval and as decided by the Competent Authority.

Read

The technically qualified Bidder who submits the lowest financial bid amount for **Diet services per person per day on total basis for Normal Diet** shall be declared as successful bidder (L1) and communication to that effect shall be made subject to approval and as decided by the Competent Authority. However, L1 bidder for Diet services per person per day on total basis for Normal Diet will be required to accept lowest rates quoted by the bidders for all remaining diets. The lowest rate quoted for each individual therapeutic diet, amongst all technically accepted tenders will be the rate at which they have to be supplied by the vendor who is awarded the contract.

3. Page No. 7, “Term and Condition” Point no. 48 ,:

For

The bidder shall have at least 3 years’ experience in last 5 years as on last date submission of tender for Dietary/Cafeteria/ Canteen Services in Government Hospitals having not less than 500 beds.

Or

Have at least 3 years experience in last 5 years as on last date submission of tender of successfully running of Mess/ canteen services in the Institute of National Importance of atleast 500 students.

Read

The bidder shall have at least 3 years' experience in last 5 years as on last date submission of tender for **Dietary/Cafeteria/Canteen Services in Government/NABH accredited Hospitals** having not less than 500 beds.

Or

Have at least 3 years experience in last 5 years as on last date submission of tender of successfully running of **Mess/ canteen services in the Institute of National Importance of atleast 500 students.**

6. Page No. 19, “Point Added below Table 1:”,

For Non Vegetarian patients, 30gm Chicken /Lean meat /Fish will be provided instead of Dal.

7. Page No. 3, “Scope of Work” Added Point No. 14:

Institute will not provide any space in the AIIMS premises for preparation of food. The successful bidder must submit documentary proof of space where the food for dietary services will be prepared. The location of the kitchen should be within a radius of 5 Kms from AIIMS, Jodhpur IPD building. The payment will made based on the number of Diets supplied and there will no minimum assured diet payment for a given period of time.

8. Page No. 3, “Scope of Work” Added Point No. 15:

The successful bidder should make sure that his work (Manpower, Space etc.) should be as per the guidelines laid by FSSAI (Food Safety and Standards Authority of India).

9. Page No. 3, “Scope of Work” Added Point No. 16:

The successful bidder must ensure that hot/ warm pre-packed food should be served to patients.

10. Distribution of food within the hospital premises will be managed by AIIMS, Jodhpur.
