All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Jodhpur, Rajasthan, an apex healthcare institute established by an Act of Parliament of India under aegis of Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India call of tender for the works pertains to Providing UPS backup supply to newly constructed OT complex at Trauma ground floor at AIIMS Jodhpur.

Instructions for the Bidder/ the service provider: -

1. **Bids shall be submitted online only at CPPP website: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>.**
2. The complete bidding process is online. Bidders should be possession of valid Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) of class II or III for online submission of bids. Prior to bidding DSC need to be registered on the website mentioned above. For any assistance for e-bidding process, if required, bidder may contact to the helpdesk at 0291-2740741.
3. **Bidder/Service Providers are advised to follow the instructions provided in the 'Instructions to the service providers/Bidders for the e-submission of the bids online through the Central Public Procurement Portal for e-Procurement at <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>'.**
Bid documents may be scanned with 100 dpi with black and white **option** which helps in reducing size of the scanned document.
4. **Criteria of Eligibility:**
The contractor who fulfils the following requirements shall be eligible to apply, Joint ventures are not accepted:
Three similar works each of value not less than 40% of the estimated cost put to Tender or Two similar works each of value not less than 60% of the estimated cost put to Tender or One similar works each of value not less than 80% of the estimated cost put to Tender within last 07 years **up to November -2023.**
Note: Completion certificate (along with documents of work done) has to be attached.
"Similar works means Electrification works that includes Installation of UPS system."
5. The value of executed work shall be brought to current costing level by enhancing the actual value of work at simple rate of 7% per annum calculated from the date of completion to the last date of previous month in which bids are received.
6. Performance guarantee equal to 5% of the contract value is required to be submitted within **07 days** from the date of issue of notification of award. The same shall be valid for **stipulated time of completion + 180 days.**
7. An amount equals to 5% of amount billed shall be withhold being Security from the GST bills and released only after successful completion of works as per specifications/ norms.
8. **Turnover:** Average annual financial turn over should be at least **50%** of the estimated cost during the immediate last **3 Consecutive Financial Years.**
9. Earnest Money Deposit: The EMD @ **₹. 28,456.00 (Rupees Twenty-Eight Thousand Four Hundred Fifty-Six Only)** shall be deposited in favor of "All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Jodhpur", Payable at Jodhpur, the same will be allowed with validity up to 180 days and of any Scheduled Bank.
➤ The Firms registered with Micro Small Medium Enterprises (MSME) / National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) / OR Small-Scale Industries (SSI) are exempted to submit the

EMD only (Copy of registration must be provided along with technical bid). **No other relaxation shall be allowed.**

- The EMD of the unsuccessful Bidders shall be refunded by after finalization of the tender.
- The EMD of L1 bidder will be released only after receipt of Performance guarantee by the L1 bidder.
- **No interest will be payable by AIIMS, Jodhpur on the EMD.**
- The Hard Copy of original instruments in respect of earnest money deposit must be delivered to the AIIMS, Jodhpur on or before the last date of submission of bid. The bid submitted without EMD will be summarily rejected

10. Submission of Tender:

The tender shall be submitted online only in two parts, viz. Technical Bid and Financial Bid on CPP portal. The Tender Acceptance Certificate must be signed and submitted along with the documents before uploading.

General Terms and Conditions

1. **Rate:** Rates to be quoted as per Financial Bid considering nature of work and cost of material involved with delivery at site / FOR, including applicable taxes, etc.
2. **Validity:** The quoted rates must be valid for a period for 180 days from the date of closing of the tender. The overall offer for the assignment and bidder(s) quoted price shall remain unchanged during the period of validity. If the bidder quoted the validity shorter than the required period, the same will be treated as unresponsive and it may be rejected. In case the tenderer withdraws, modifies or changes his offer during the validity period, bid is liable to be rejected without assigning any reason thereof. The bidder should also be ready to extend the validity, if required, without changing any terms, conditions etc. of their original tender. In case the last date of receipt of tender / of opening the tender is declared as Holidays, the respective dates shall be treated as postponed to the next working day accordingly.
3. **Technical Evaluation:**
 - a. Detailed technical evaluation shall be carried out by Institute pursuant to conditions in the tender document to determine the substantial responsiveness of each tender. For this clause, the substantially responsive bid is one that conforms to all the eligibility and terms and conditions of the tender without any deviation.
 - b. The determination of bid's responsiveness is to be based on the contents of the bid itself without recourse to extrinsic evidence. The evaluation of the technical bids will also be done to determine whether they are complete, required sureties have been furnished, all the documents have been properly authorized and are in order.
4. **Financial Evaluation:** After due evaluation of the bid(s) AIIMS, Jodhpur will award the contract to the lowest evaluated responsive tenderer on a composite basis.
5. **Right of acceptance:** The Client have right to accept or reject any or all tenders or cancel or withdraw the tender notice without assigning any reasons thereof. Also, does not bind itself to accept the lowest quotation or any tender and no claim in this regard shall be entertained. Conditional bid/s will be treated as unresponsive and will be rejected.
6. **Award of Contract:** The Institute shall consider placement of orders for jobs on those bidders whose offers have been found technical and financially acceptable.
7. **Signing of Contract:** The successful bidder shall be required to execute the Contract Agreement accepting all terms and conditions stipulated herein on a non-judicial stamp paper of appropriate value within fifteen days of the issue of the Letter of notification of award along with performance security. In the event of failure on the part of the successful bidder to sign the Contract within the period stipulated above, the EMD shall be forfeited and the acceptance of BID shall be considered as cancelled.
8. **Performance bank guarantee:**
 - a. As a contract security for faithful performance of the contract in accordance with all the terms and conditions specified in the tender, the successful bidder shall furnish a Performance bank guarantee @ 5% of order value in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt or

Bank Guarantee from any Nationalized Bank duly pledged in the name of the "All India Institute of Medical Sciences, Jodhpur" after receipt of work order.

- b. The client has the right to encash the PBG in full or part for non-compliance of any or all the terms and conditions of the tender / contract and to recover any Liquid Damages and penalties under the contract as well as against defects in any work as enumerated in the tender / contract. In case of part encashment, the validity of the PBG shall have to be kept valid for the remaining period as per contract, for the balance amount or for a period as required by the client.
- c. **Refund of PBG:** The Performance bank guarantee will be refunded after completion of work in accordance with all the contractual obligations and issuance of completion certificate from Engineer-In-Charge. No interest will be admissible / paid on PBG.

9. Security deposit:

- a) An amount @2.5% of the billing amount shall be deducted from the contractor's bill/s as security deposit.
- b) Refund of Security deposit: The amount deducted from contractor's bill/s as security deposit shall be refunded after completion of warranty period of material supplied, all types of contractual liability of the contractor and clearance from the Engineer-In-Charge.

10. Authority of person signing document: A person signing the tender form or any documents forming part of the contract on behalf of another shall be deemed to warranty, that he has authority to bind such other and if, on enquiry, it appears that the person so, signing had no authority to do so, the Executive Director, AIIMS, Jodhpur may without prejudice to other Civil and criminal remedies cancel contract and held the signatory liable for all cost and damages.

11. Right of acceptance: The Executive Director, AIIMS, Jodhpur reserves the right to accept the whole or any part or portion of the bid; and the bidder shall provide the same at the rates quoted. The Executive Director, AIIMS, Jodhpur reserve the right to reject any or all tenders /quotations or all offers received in response to the tender or cancel or withdraw the tender notice without assigning any reason thereof and also does not bind itself to accept the lowest quotation or any tender and no claim in this regard shall be entertained. Right to issue and to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof is reserved by the Competent Authority.

12. Sample approval:

- a. After award of contract, successful bidder shall have to get advance sample approved from Buyer before starting bulk supplies. Successful bidder shall submit one sample approval within 10 days of award of contract.
- b. Buyer shall, as per contract specifications framework, either approve the advance sample or will provide a complete list of modification required in the sample within 5 days of receipt of advance sample. Seller shall be required to ensure supply as per approved sample with modifications as communicated by Buyer.
- c. If there is delay from buyer side in approval of advance sample, the delivery period shall be re-fixed without LD for the period of delay in sample approval. In case, the sample is found to have major deviations / not conforming to the Contract specifications, the buyer at its discretion may call for fresh samples for approval before allowing bulk

supplies or may terminate the contract after notifying the deviations to the seller. All samples required for the test shall be supplied by the contractor free of cost. d) Where under the contract, the contractor is required to submit an advance sample, any expenses incurred by the contractor on or in connection with the production of stores in bulk, before the sample has been approved unconditionally shall be borne by the Seller and he shall not claim any compensation in the event of such sample being found unacceptable by the Buyer / Consignee.

13. Inspection / Testing:

- a. The authorized representative of AIIMS, Jodhpur shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the goods to confirm their conformity to the NIT Specifications at no extra cost to the Purchaser.
- b. The authorized representative of AIIMS, Jodhpur has right to inspect, test and, where necessary, reject the Goods after the goods arrival at the final destination and shall in no way be limited or waived by reason of the Goods having previously been inspected, tested and passed by AIIMS, Jodhpur prior to the goods shipment.
- c. The Executive Director, AIIMS Jodhpur or his authorized representative shall be the final authority to reject full or any part of the supply which is not conforming to the specification and other terms and conditions.
- d. The rejected goods shall be replaced by the bidder free of cost within 10 days of intimation by the Engineer In-charge. Only goods found in working condition without any defects shall be accepted.

14. Right to issue and to accept or reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason thereof is reserved by the Competent Authority.

15. Rate should be quoted in Indian Rupees (INR) on DOOR Basis Delivery at AIIMS, Jodhpur inclusive of all charges. The service provider shall take into account all the costs involved in compliance of all the special conditions as stated above while quoting his rates in his tender for this work. No transportation/ cartage charges will be provided for the same.

16. Bidder shall submit a GST invoice for the material to be supplied along with lot number mentioned on it.

17. **Subletting of Work:** The firm shall not assign or sublet the work/job or any part of it to any other person/party. The tender is not transferable. Only one tender shall be submitted by one bidder.

18. **Breach of Terms and Conditions:** Non-compliance of any terms and conditions enumerated in the contract shall be treated as breach of contract. In case of breach of any terms and conditions as mentioned in tender, the Competent Authority, will have the right to reject the bid at any stage without assigning any reason thereof and nothing will be payable by AIIMS, Jodhpur in that event the bid shall also stands forfeited.

19. After the evaluation of the bid(s) AIIMS, Jodhpur will award the contract to the lowest evaluated responsive bidder on composite basis. Conditional bids will be treated as unresponsive and will be rejected.

20. Applicable Law:

- a. The contract shall be governed by laws and procedures established by Govt. of India, within the framework of applicable legislation and enactment made from time to time concerning such commercial dealings/ processing.
- b. Any disputes are subject to exclusive jurisdiction of competent court and forum in Jodhpur, Rajasthan, India only.
- c. The Arbitration shall be held in accordance with the provision of the Arbitration and conciliation Act, 2021 and the venue of arbitration shall be at Jodhpur. The decision of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties.
- d. Force Majeure: Any delay due to Force Majeure will not be attributable to the service provider.

21. **Guarantee / Warranty Period:** Warranty period of the supplied products shall be as per additional specification parameters mentioned in the bid document from the date of final acceptance of goods after testing. The contractor must provide the OEM warranty / guarantee certificates for the supplied material at the time of delivery. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any breakdown during the guarantee period.

22. The quantities are approximate and are liable to change up to any extent on either side. The Engineer-In-Charge reserves the right to order deviation from the quantities mentioned in the tender. The contractor shall supply the additional quantity on the rates quoted in the tender documents irrespective of deviation limit mentioned elsewhere in the agreement. The contractor shall have no claim to any payment or compensation whatsoever on account of any profit or advantage which might have derived from the execution of supply in full as mentioned in tender but which did not derive any consequence of the full supply of material mentioned in tender not having been ordered.

23. Any information / document required for verification shall be provided by the bidder.

24. Contractor shall be fully responsible for any damages caused to the government property by his or his labour in carrying out the work and shall be rectified by the contractor at his own cost. Rejected materials shall have to be removed by the contractor at his own cost within a week of the instructions of doing so.

25. If any contradiction arises between the above mentioned terms and conditions & terms and conditions of GeM portal, the above mentioned terms and conditions will prevail
